An Ordinance to Extend the Limits of the City of St. Mary, Mo.

SECTION

354. (1) Extended City Limits Described, and to be Voted Upon.
355. (2) Style of Tickets.

Be it Ordained by the Board of Aldermen of the City of St. Mary, Mo., as follows:

SEC. 354. (1) That the question of extending the city limits of the said city of St. Mary, over the following territory lying adjacent to said city to-wit: Beginning on the present corporation line at a point on the northern line of Elm street where it intersects the north line of John Tlappek's land, and run thence along the northern boundary line of John Tlappek, Louis Schaaf, Edward Schaaf, J. F. Bartels, Sr., and Mrs. Geo. Eller's lands, north 45° W. 1373 feet to where the extension of the line between the Eller's place and T. E. Picon land intersects the south line of the county road; Thence south 50° west with said line to a stone at the S. W. corner of Eller's land; Thence S. 38° E. along south line of Mrs. Eller's, J. F. Bartels, Sr., Edward Schaaf, Louis Schaaf, Walter Schaaf and John Tlappek, 1358 feet to a point on the northeastern line of graveyard road 30 feet north 50° east from a stone at corner between T. B.

Whitledge and Stephen Friedman; Thence S. 42° E. 288 feet to corner of John Tlapek and Reuben Cole; Thence S. 60° E. 700 feet; Thence S. 49° E. 150 feet to north line of Sycamore street; Thence S. 50° E. 1678 feet to the north line of Cedar street at the intersection of 6th street with Cedar a point in the present corporate line, shall be submitted to a vote of the legal voters of said city of St. Mary at the time and place to be hereafter designated in a proclamation issued by the Mayor of said city of St. Mary, giving notice of such election, same to be published in some newspaper in the city of St. Mary, four consecutive issues previous to the day of election fixed by the Mayor.

SEC. 355. (2) That the style of the tickets to be voted at said election so ordered by the mayor shall be as follows:

For the extension of the City Limits—Yes.

For the extension of the City Limits—No.

(Erase the word you do not favor.)

The Mayor shall fix the time and place for holding said election; provided, however, that he may fix the same at the general or regular election for the election of city officers to be held on Tuesday April 3rd A. D. 1907.
