ORDINANCE NO. 530

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 473 RELATING TO PROHIBITING THE USE OF CERTAIN "ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES" IN THE CITY OF ST. MARYS, MISSOURI.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF ST. MARY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE: Definitions

a. "All-Terrain Vehicles" shall mean any motorized vehicle manufactured exclusively for off-highway use which is fifty inches or less in width, with an unladen dry weight of six hundred pounds or less, traveling on three or more low pressure tires, with a seat designed to be straddled by the operator, and handlebars for steering control.

b. "Motor vehicle" shall mean any self-propelled vehicle not operated exclusively upon tracks, except farm tractors.

SECTION TWO: It shall be unlawful to operate on any street in the City of St. Marys a motor vehicle or an all terrain vehicle unless said vehicle displays unexpired state license plated issued for that vehicle. No unlicensed all-terrain vehicles may be operated on any street within the City of St. Marys.

SECTION THREE: Conviction for the violation of this ordinance shall result in a fine of up to Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) and imprisonment of up to 30 days in the city jail, or both.

SECTION FOUR: This Ordinance shall be effective from and after its passage.
