ORDINANCE NO. 299

In repeal of SECTION 15, of ORDINANCE NO. 176-----

No person having a license under the provisions of this act shall sell, give away, or otherwise dispose of, or suffer the same to be done upon or about his premises, any intoxicating liquor in any quantity between the hours of 1:30 o'clock A.M. and 6:00 o'clock A.M. on any day of the week.


"When December Thirty-first falls on Sunday, any person having license to sell intoxicating liquor by the drink may be open for business and sell intoxicating liquor by the drink under the provisions of his license on that day after 1:00 p.m. and until the time which should be lawful on another day of the week, notwithstanding any provisions of sections 311.290 og 563.720, RSMo., or any other provisions of law to the contrary."


The new provision of law applies exclusively to sale of Intoxicating Liquor by the Drink-. This classification includes full liquor by drink licensees, 5% beer by drink licenees, and consupcion of liquor on premises licensees, all of which may open for business at 1;00 pm New Years Eve, and remain open until 130 a.m.

Restaurants, bars and taverns opening for sale by the drink under the provisions of this new law, may not sell or dispense any package liquor or beer on New Years Eve.

Shall take effect immediately after its passage. Any ordinance or ordinances, part or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
