

AN ORDINANCE ABANDONING CEDAR STREET ON THE NORTH SIDE OF BLOCK 42 BETWEEN SIXTH AND SEVENTH STREETS IN THE CITY OF ST. MARY, MISSOURI.

Be It Ordained by the Board of Aldermen of the City of St. Mary, Missouri, as follows:

SECTION ONE: That Cedar Street on the North side of Block 42 between Sixth and Seventh Streets in the City of St. Mary, Missouri, together with the alley extending through said Block 42, be and the same is hereby declared to be abandoned and that any and all claims held by the City of said street and alley are hereby released and relinquished by said City.

SECTION TWO: That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.
