ORDINANCE NO. 336

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING THAT PART OF ORDINANCE NO. 312, DATED MARCH 4, 1970 AND DESIGNATED AS "SECTION 2, SPEED LIMITS" AND ESTABLISHING HERewith A NEW SECTION 2, PERTAINING TO THE REGULATION OF THE SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES WITHIN THE CITY OF ST. MARYS, MISSOURI, AND DESIGNATING THE TIME WHEN THIS ORDINANCE NO. 336 SHALL TAKE EFFECT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF ST. MARYS MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1

MANNER OF OPERATING MOTOR VEHICLES

Every person operating a motor vehicle on the streets of the City of St. Marys shall drive such vehicle in a careful and prudent manner and at a rate of speed so as not to endanger the life or property of another and shall exercise the highest degree of care.

SECTION 2

SPEED LIMITS

No motor vehicle shall be operated upon the streets of the City of St. Marys:

- a. In excess of twenty (20) miles per hour, 30 miles per hour on Highway 61.
- b. In excess of fifteen (15) miles per hour in any area designated as a school or church zone by the Board of Aldermen, by appropriate resolution and when signs are duly erected as ordered by said Board. A school or church zone as used here-in-after is defined as the area within 150 feet of church or school.
- c. In excess of fifteen (15) miles per hour in any emergency zone when appropriate signs are erected by the City Marshal or a Deputy. An emergency zone shall be an area where construction work is taking place, where an accident has occurred or any other emergency situation which would endanger the lives or property of any citizen of St. Marys, Missouri.

SECTION 3

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed.

SECTION 4

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from its passage and approval.
