ORDINANCE NO. 356

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR A SPECIAL ELECTION IN THE CITY OF ST. MARY, MISSOURI, STE. GLENEVIEVE COUNTY, MISSOURI: SETTING A DATE OF ELECTION: DESIGNATING A POLLING PLACE: NAMING THE JUDGES OF SAID ELECTION: PRESCRIBING THE FORM OF NOTICE OF SAID ELECTION: AND DIRECTING THE PUBLICATION OF SAID NOTICE. THE PURPOSE OF SAID ELECTION BEING TO SUBMIT TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF SAID CITY A PROPOSAL FOR MANDATORY OR NON-MANDATORY SOLID WASTE COLLECTION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF ST. MARY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The date of the special election shall be December 2, 1975

SECTION 2. To vote for Mandatory or Non-Mandatory Solid Waste Collection.


SECTION 3. The Polling Place is designated as City Hall. Polls will be opened at 6:00 A.M. and shall remain open until 7:00 P.M. of said date. This polling place will be for both Ward 1 and Ward 2.

SECTION 4. The following Judges and Clerks for the election are hereby appointed as follows: Mrs. Eileen Vogt., Mrs. Leona Thompson, Mrs. Minnie Taylor, Mrs. Mabel Worley and Mrs. Patricia Worley. Alternate: Mrs. Eva Cissell


SECTION 5. The City Clerk is hereby directed to have the notice of the above election on December 2, 1975, published at least three weeks prior to the election.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from its passage and approval.
