

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE FARMERS HOME ADMINISTRATION PROVIDING THAT APPLICANT, CITY OF ST. MARYS, MISSOURI, WILL NOT DIRECTLY OR THROUGH CONTRACTUAL OR OTHER ARRANGEMENTS, SUBJECT OR CAUSE ANY PERSON TO BE SUBJECT TO DISCRIMINATION ON THE GROUNDS OF RACE, COLOR, SEX, OR NATIONAL ORIGIN WITH RESPECT TO ANY FACILITY OR ACTIVITY OF THE APPLICANT, REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith AND DESIGNATING THE TIME THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF ST. MARYS, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: That the City of St. Marys, Missouri, has applied for a loan from the United States Department of Agriculture Farmers Home Administration and that the Mayor of the City is hereby authorized on behalf of said City to execute a document known as a Non-Discrimination Agreement, which provides that the applicant will not directly or through contractual or other arrangements object or cause any person to be subject to discrimination on the grounds of race, color, sex and national origin with respect to any facility or activity of the applicant.

SECTION 2: That the City of St. Marys, Missouri, does hereby agree that it will not directly or through contractual or other arrangements subject or cause any person to be subject to discrimination on the grounds of race, color, sex or national origin with respect to any facility or activity of the City.

SECTION 3: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
