

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LICENSING OF PERSONS ENGAGED IN THE SALE OF INTOXICATING LIQUOR AND NON-INTOXICATING BEER; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith AND DESIGNATING THE TIME WHEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF ST. MARY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. DEFINITIONS;

"Sale of intoxicating liquor by the drink" shall include the sale of liquor in either the original package or by the drink for consumption on the premises.

"Intoxicating liquor" is defined as all alcoholic beverages containing more than 5% alcohol by volume.

"Non-Intoxicating beer" is defined as all beer containing less than 3.2% alcohol by volume.

Section 2. Not more than three (3) licenses per one thousand (1000) population will be issued at this time to persons selling liquor by the drink within the City of St. Mary, Missouri. If any-one of the present licenses should not be renewed, the number of licenses issued will be reduced to two (2) per one thousand (1000) population.

Section 3. The license fee for selling intoxicating liquor and non-intoxicating beer within the City of St. Mary, Missouri, shall be as follows:

Intoxicating liquor by the drink shall be \$175.00 per annum


Special Licenses to sell non-intoxicating beer shall be \$3.00 per day for a maximum of three (3) days.

Section 4. All licenses shall be due on July 1 and January 1 of each year.

Section 5. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
