ORDINANCE NO. 426

An Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 176, Section XV, Dated December 28, 1934, An Ordinance Regulating and Controlling the Sale of Intoxicating Liquor both wholesale and retail and designating when this Ordinance shall take effect.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF ST. MARY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:


SECTION I. Ordinance No.176, Section XV, shall read as follows: No person having a license under this Ordinance, nor any employee of such person, shall sell, give away, or otherwise dispose of, or suffer the same to be done upon or about his premises, any intoxicating liquor in any quantity between the hours of 1:30 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. on weekdays and between the hours of 1:30 a.m. Sunday and 6:00 a.m. Monday, or after 1:30 a.m. upon the day of any general election in this state held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November of even-numbered years and the primary election held preceding such general election. If a person has a license to sell intoxicating liquor by the drink, his premises shall be and remain a closed place as defined in this section after 1:30 a.m. upon the day of any general election in this state held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November of even-numbered years and the primary election held preceding such general election and between the hours of 1:30 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. on weekdays and between the hours of 1:30 a.m. Sunday and 6:00 a.m. Monday; except that the sale of intoxicating liquor may be resumed and the premises reopened on any such general or primary election day after the expiration of thirty minutes next following the hour or time fixed by law for the closing of the polls at any such election.

SECTION II. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with the above are hereby repealed.


SECTION III. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
