

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE USE OF CERTAIN "ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES" IN THE CITY OF ST. MARY, MISSOURI.

SECTION 1. Definitions

a. "All-Terrain Vehicles" shall mean any motorized vehicle manufactured exclusively for off-highway use which is fifty inches or less in width, with an unladen dry weight of six hundred pounds or less, traveling on three or more low pressure tires, with a seat designed to be straddled by the operator, and handlebars for steering control.

b. "Motor vehicle" shall mean any self-propelled vehicle not operated exclusively upon tracks, except farm tractors and all-terrain vehicles.

SECTION 2.

It shall be unlawful to operate any vehicle or all terrain vehicle on any city property except upon paved or graveled streets located therein. No all-terrain vehicles shall be operated on or in any city owned property.

SECTION 3.

Conviction for the violation of this ordinance shall result in a fine of up to Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) and imprisonment of up to 30 days in the city jail, or both.

SECTION 4.

This ordinance shall be effective from and after its passage and approval.
