

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE FAILURE TO HOOK UP TO THE CITY OF SAINT MARY'S SANITARY SEWER SYSTEM A NUISANCE; AUTHORIZING THE TERMINATION OF WATER SERVICE TO ABATE SUCH NUISANCES.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED:

SECTION ONE: The failure of any owner or occupier of property within the City Limits of the City of Saint Mary to connect such property to the sanitary sewer system is hereby declared a nuisance.

SECTION TWO: Ten (10) days after notice mailed certified, return receipt requested, to the last known address of the owner of the property and the occupier of the property, the City shall immediately terminate all water service to said property.

SECTION THREE: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict are hereby repealed.

SECTION FOUR: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
