

AN ORDINANCE REVISING THE DELINQUENT PAYMENT CHARGE ON WATER BILLS AND ESTABLISHING A NEW SCHEDULE FOR PAYMENT OF WATER BILLS WHEREBY AMENDING ORDINANCE NO.318 SECTION 3 AND ORDINANCE NO. 414 SECTION 1; AND STATING WHEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF ST. MARY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. A delinquent payment charge of 10% per month of the amount of the bill shall be added to all bills not paid by the 10th day of the month that they are billed, regardless of when bills are mailed prior to the 10th of the month.

SECTION 2. The city reserves the right to discontinue water service to any location served water because of nonpayment of bill or where tenant or property owner is guilty of any violation of the Ordinances of the City of St. Mary, Missouri pertaining to water usage. Payments are due when bills are rendered. Any payment not received by the city by the 10th (tenth) day of the month shall be delinquent. The city collector shall notify all delinquent accounts after the 10th day of the month that unless such charges are paid within 10 days water service to said consumer's premises will be discontinued and such service will not be restored until all delinquent charges due the city, including all penalties and charges have been paid.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
