

AN ORDINANCE GIVING THE TREASURER THE AUTHORITY TO APPLY THE WATER METER DEPOSIT TO UNPAID WATER/SEWER BILLS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF ST. MARY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:


SECTION 1. If a water customer shall not pay his account after his water service has been disconnected, the City Treasurer shall apply the water meter deposit to any bill delinquent more than thirty (30) days. The City Collector shall present a list of delinquent accounts to the City Board of Aldermen at their regular monthly and make note of those that have been disconnected. The treasurer is authorized to apply the deposit without the approval of the Board after the 30 days period.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.

SECTION 3. All Ordinances and parts thereof in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent to such inconsistency.




