

AN ORDINANCE ALLOWING FOR THE PAYMENT OF GASOLINE FOR CITY OFFICIALS WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN AT EACH MEETING.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF ST. MARY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. This ordinance shall allow for the payment of gasoline charges incurred by city officials for city business only. These bills are to be presented for payment at the monthly Board of Aldermen meeting. Each bill for gasoline is to be reviewed separately and paid only on the majority vote of the board. Each city official is to provide a complete and accurate accounting for the purpose the gasoline was used. The payment of a gasoline bill must be for emergency trips for the city, use of private auto for department that they head or other use the board may feel make it warranted.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
