



BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF ST. MARY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:


SECTION 1. This ordinance allows participants who have been hired by the City of St. Mary, MO to be Flood Relief Works to work on private property. Working on private property will be allowed for this clean up only and each location must be approved by the city. This work on private property will be under the direction of the city.

Passed and approved this the 14th day of September, 1993.


