

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 501 AND PROVIDING FOR THE COLLECTION OF COURT COSTS USED IN THE TRAINING OF PEACE OFFICERS AND DESIGNATING WHEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF ST. MARY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. The official responsible for collecting court cost and fines may assess as court costs up to three (\$3.00) for each violation of the general criminal laws of the State, including infractions, or violations of the ordinances of the City of St. Mary, provided that no such fee shall be collected for non-moving traffic violations, and no such fee shall be collected for violations of fish and game regulations, and no such fee shall be collected in any proceeding in any court when the proceeding or defendant has been dismissed by the court.

SECTION II. Two dollars (\$2.00) of such fees collected shall be transmitted monthly to the Treasurer of the City, to be used locally for training law enforcement officers. One dollar (\$1.00) of such fees collected shall be deposited into the Peace Officer Standards and Training Commission Fund, to be used statewide for training law enforcement officers. 
SECTION III. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.


