ORDINANCE NO. 633

AN ORDINANCE SUBMITTING TO THE VOTERS OF THE CITY OF ST. MARY THE ISSUE OF WHETHER TO IMPOSE A ONE-HALF OF ONE PERCENT SALES TAX FOR TRANSPORTATION PURPOSES AFTER VOTER APPROVAL.

WHEREAS, Sections 94.700 to 94.755 of the Revised Statutes of the State of Missouri allows the Mayor and Board of Aldermen to impose and collect a one-half of one percent sales tax for transportation purposes, and

WHEREAS, this power to impose such a sales tax only becomes effective after the approval by a majority of the voters voting at an election is received,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

SECTION ONE: The Mayor and Board of Aldermen shall impose and collect a one-half percent sales tax on the receipts from the sale at retail of all tangible personal property or taxable services at retail with the city limits. This section shall only be effective after voter approval of the question set out in section two of this ordinance.

SECTION TWO: It is hereby ordered that the following question in the following form, be submitted to the voters of the City of St. Mary at an election to be held November 5, 1996:

"Shall the City of St. Mary impose a sales tax of one-half of one percent (.005%) for transportation purposes?"


