

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING VEHICLE RESTRICTIONS ON SEVENTH STREET BETWEEN MULBERRY STREET AND SPRUCE STREET.

WHEREAS, certain sections of Seventh Street are very steep, and

WHEREAS, certain size vehicles are having difficulty in climbing this street, and

WHEREAS, vehicles are damaging this street because of these factors, and

WHEREAS, the City Marshal has asked that certain vehicles be banned,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF ST. MARY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Trailers, campers, Recreational Vehicles and trucks over 12,000 lbs. are banned on Seventh Street between Mulberry Street and Spruce Street because of this section of the street is too steep for these vehicles to climb.

SECTION 2. The Street Commissioner is hereby ordered and directed to erect suitable signs indicating that certain vehicles cannot travel this section of Seventh Street.

SECTION 3. Violation of this ordinance shall be considered a misdemeanor and upon conviction may be fined up to \$500.00 or by punishment for up to 90 days in jail or fine and punishment both.


SECTION 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict are hereby repealed.
