

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING STOP SIGNS AT DESIGNATED LOCATIONS AND SETTING WHEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF ST. MARY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. A three way stop shall be established at the Corner of Third Street and Walnut Street. There shall be stop signs on Walnut and each corner of Third Street.

A two way stop shall be established at the Corner of Third Street and Cedar Street with the stop signs on Third Street allowing Cedar Street to be a through street.


SECTION 2. All ordinances in conflict are hereby repealed.
