ORDINANCE NO. 721

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING FIFTEEN-MINUTE PARKING AT CITY HALL ON ELECTION DAYS AND DESIGNATING WHEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF ST. MARY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The Board of Aldermen hereby establish a fifteen-minute parking zone at the St. Mary City Hall located at 782 3rd Street for election days. Whenever a parking area is clearly marked by a sign or symbol it shall be unlawful to park or stand any motor vehicle in such area for period of more than fifteen (15) minutes.


SECTION 2. Any police officer who finds a motor vehicle parked in violation of this ordinance shall issue a parking ticket/violation and place the parking ticket/citation on such vehicle.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
