

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE EXTENSION AND IMPROVMENTS TO THE CITY CEMETERY FOR THE CITY OF ST. MARY, MISSOURI.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF ST.MARY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The Board of Aldermen of the City of St. Mary, Missouri finds it necessary and hereby declares its intent to extend and improve the City's Cemetery, including acquiring land and constructing roads, according to the plat on file with the City Clerk

SECTION 2. The Board of Aldermen finds the cemetery improvement project necessary and beneficial to the whole of the City, it's residents and the general public, and that the acquisition of additional land for expansion of the cemetery is necessary.


SECTION 3. The City Attorneys, Frank J. Elpers and Tim Inman, are hereby authorized and directed to file condemnation actions for all the tracts, parcels of land, all easements and right of ways required for this project whenever the city is unable to acquire same by negotiation, purchase or gift.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.

SECTION 5. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance shall be, and the same are hereby repealed insofar as they may be conflict.

SECTION 6. The invalidity of any section, clause, sentence, or provision of this ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other part of this ordinance which can be given effect without such invalid part or parts.
