ORDINANCE NO. 893

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A THREE DOLLAR (\$3.00) SURCHARGE TO BE COLLECTED ON ANY VIOLATION OF LAW BY THE MUNICIPAL COURT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF ST. MARY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Sheriff's Retirement Fund. There shall be assessed and collected a surcharge of three dollars (\$3.00) in all criminal cases including violation of any county ordinance or any violation of criminal or traffic laws of this state, including infractions, but no such surcharge shall be assessed when the costs are waived or are to be paid by the state, county or municipality or when a criminal proceeding or the defendant has been dismissed by the court. The clerk responsible for collecting court shall collect and disburse such amounts as provided by Sections 488.010 to 488.020, RSMo. Such funds shall be payable to the sheriffs' retirement fund.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect on August 28, 2013.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict are hereby repealed.
