

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A HANDICAPPED PARKING SPACE AT CITY HALL AND SETTING A TIME LIMIT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF ST. MARY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1 - DEFINATIONS:

Handicapped shall be defined as a person with a handicapped license plate or handicapped placard hanging from the rear view mirror.

Regular Business Hours shall be defined as the hours of operation of City Hall. They are as follows:

Monday	9:00 AM to 3:00 PM
Tuesday	9:00 AM to 3:00 PM
Wednesday	9:00 AM to 3:00 PM
Thursday	9:00 AM to 4:30 PM
Friday	9:00 AM to 3:30 PM

Election Hours shall be defined as the hours of operation of City Hall during an election. They are as follows:

Election Hours 6:00 AM to 7:00 PM

SECTION 2 - VIOLATION:

Any vehicle operator that parks in the handicapped parking at city hall that does not have a handicapped license plate or placard is in violation.

Any vehicle operator that parks in the handicapped parking at city hall that does have a handicapped license plate or placard but is parked more than 10 minutes during regular business hours or election hours is in violation.


SECTION 3 - PENELATY:

Any vehicle operator that violates this ordinance shall be fined not less than \$25.00 and no more than \$500.00 plus court costs.
