ORDINANCE NO. 920

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING LICENSING AND CONTROL OF ANIMALS ORDINANCE 613, SECTION 10, DESIGNATING WHEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF ST. MARY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 10. Dogs running at large prohibited:


It shall be unlawful for any person having the care or control of a dog to allow such dog to run at large within the city. No dog shall be allowed to roam upon the streets or sidewalks of the city unless the dog is securely fastened to a leash and the leash held by some person at all times. Failure to comply shall be subject to a fine of not more than \$100.00 (One Hundred Dollars) but not less than \$25.00 (Twenty Five Dollars).

It shall be unlawful for any person having the care or control of a dog to allow such dog to run at large onto other resident's private property and bite a person or pet. Failure to comply shall be subject to a fine of not more than \$500.00 (Five Hundred Dollars) but not less than \$100.00 (One Hundred Dollars).
