ORDINANCE NO. 971

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING AND REPLACING AN ORDINANCE 666 ESTABLISHING STOP SIGNS AT DESIGNATED LOCATIONS AND STATING WHEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT.

BE ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF ST. MARY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. A two way stop shall be established at the Corner of Third Street and Cedar Street with Stop Signs placed at the intersection on Third Street both ways and the Stop Sign on Cedar Street going West (coming down the hill) will be removed.

SECTION 2. All ordinance or parts of ordinances in conflict are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
